- This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in UNDB online (GPN Ref. No. AfDB266-02/19) of 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019 and on the African Development Bank Group's Internet Website.
- The Government of Republic of Kenya has received financing from the African Development Bank hereinafter called the Bank toward the cost of the Nairobi Rivers Basin Rehabilitation and Restoration Program: Sewerage Improvement Project - Phase II, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Upgrading of ICT Systems for Athi Water Works Development Agency (AWWDA).
- The Athi Water Works Development Agency now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the upgrading of ICT systems for AWWDA, comprising: -
  - the supply, delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of storage infrastructure;
  - supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of three (3) No. 42U rack cabinets with migration of existing infrastructure;
  - supply, delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of two (2) No. SAN switches;
  - supply, delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of one (1) data centre environmental monitoring and security system; and
  - supply, delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of interactive displays comprising one (1) No. 75-inch unit and one (1) No. 98-inch units.
- Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (National), (OCBN) method as specified in the Bank's **Procurement Framework** dated October 2015, and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework.
